BE ALERT to...

Rogue Traders

Residents are advised to be aware of a rogue trader offering to install patios and driveways in a neighbouring village. If you require any type of work it is better to source someone by using the Trading Standards Approved Trader Scheme or recommendations from family, friends and other residents.

We have received information about a rogue trader offering to pressure wash driveways and then spotting missing or broken roof tiles.

Please ensure that you obtain **two or three written quotations** before agreeing to have work carried out. The quotation should provide details of the two week cooling off period, in case you want to change your mind.

Home & Shed Burglary
